**Luncheon Speaker: Justin K. Phillips**, Founder and Executive Director of Overdose Lifeline, Inc.

Overdose Lifeline is an Indiana nonprofit organization with a mission to carry the message of HOPE to individuals, families, and communities affected by the disease of addiction/substance use. The organization was founded in 2014 by Justin Phillips after the loss of her middle son Aaron to a heroin overdose. The nonprofits' programs and initiatives focus on impacting the opioid (pain pill and heroin) epidemic through education, harm reduction, prevention, and support.

Justin Phillips is a mother of three children, two boys and a girl. Justin has spent her career in the nonprofit and public sector educating parents and caregivers on the prevention of childhood injuries. In her personal life she has involved herself with the important cause of alcohol and drug recovery. Despite her best efforts, she could not help Aaron win his fight or beat the powerful drug heroin.
